

**Modalities for Referendum**

1. The referendum of students to resolve the issue of formation of College Students' Union and its affiliation to Delhi University Students' Union (DUSU) will be held simultaneously for both on May 02, 2018 (10:00 AM to 1:00 PM and 1:30 PM to 3:00 PM) and will be valid for a minimum period of three years.
2. Regular students of the college in full time regular courses and not in diploma/certificate courses shall be eligible to vote in this referendum. The list will be published on the college notice board & website by April 25, 2018 and objections/representations will be accepted till April 27, 2018 (3:00 PM). Final list of eligible students will be published on May 01, 2018 by 1:00 PM.
3. As per DUSU Constitution, Chapter II 6.(ii), the resolution for the formation of College Students' Union and its affiliation to Delhi University Students' Union (DUSU) adopted by absolute majority (50% of total students +1 in favour of "Yes") of the total number of regular students of the college will be valid.
4. Students having a valid college identity card (no other proof shall be accepted) will only be allowed to enter the polling area from 9:55 AM to 12:45 PM and from 1:25 PM to 2:30 PM on May 02, 2018 for voting.
5. Separate ballot papers and ballot boxes will be used for formation of College Students' Union and its affiliation to Delhi University Students' Union (DUSU).
6. The shortlisted/selected class representatives (CR) on duty will be issued the gate pass on May 01, 2018 and will report before 9:45 AM at the assigned polling booth on May 02, 2018.
7. Students will not be allowed to carry mobile phones or any other electronic gadget inside the polling area of the college on the entire day of May 02, 2018 inclusive of voting and counting.
8. The student must leave the polling area immediately after casting his/her vote.
9. No outsider will be allowed to enter the polling area under any circumstances without the prior permission of the Principal.
10. The shortlisted/selected Class Representatives (CR) of Semester VI are required to be present during counting of votes and compilation of result on May 02, 2018 from 4:00 PM onwards .and the result will be officially declared by the Principal after the compilation of result on the same day.
11. The ballot paper will have NOTA (None of the Above) option. NOTA option will be treated as against the resolution.
12. CCTV cameras surveillance and video recording will be arranged for the entire polling process and counting.
13. No campaign whatsoever before and during the referendum will be allowed by any student to influence the students **For** or **Against** the referendum. Any student found involved in this activity will be debarred from voting and strict disciplinary action will be taken as per ordinance XV B of University of Delhi.
14. Use of any unfair means by any student or staff before or during the referendum to influence the students would lead to cancellation of the referendum.
15. If referendum is in favour of formation of students' union in the college, it will be effective from the date to be notified by the Principal of the college.
16. If the referendum is in favour of affiliation of College Students' Union to DUSU, it will be effective from the date to be notified by the Patron of DUSU (Vice Chancellor, University of Delhi, Delhi as per DUSU Constitution, Chapter II 6.(v).
