1. Vision Statement

The college was established in the year 1994. It started functioning from a school building in Keshavpuram with just two courses to begin with namely B.Com (H) and B.Sc. (Gen) with Computer Science. Gradually course like B.Sc. (H) Electronics, B.Sc.(Gen) Mathematical Science, PGDCA and B.Sc.(H) Computer Science were added. The new campus of the college at Pitampura started functioning from academic session 2006-07 and courses like B.Sc. (H) Mathematics, B.Sc.(H) Physics, B.A. (H) Psychology and Bachelor of Business studies were added.

The college expects objective and considered support from citizens of Delhi as well as persons directly associated with the affairs of the college and the University of Delhi.

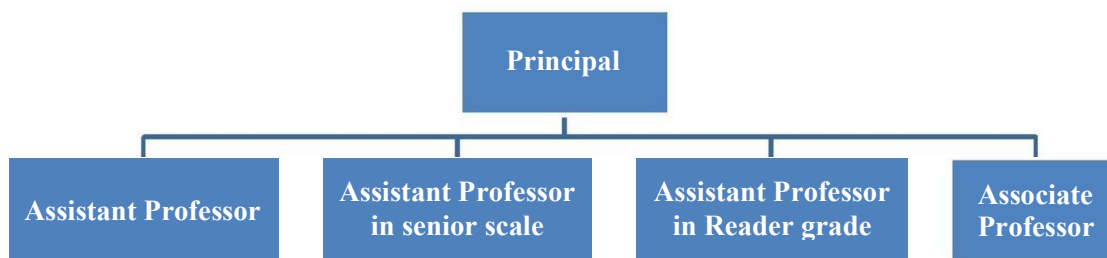
6. Arrangements and methods made for seeking public participation/ contribution

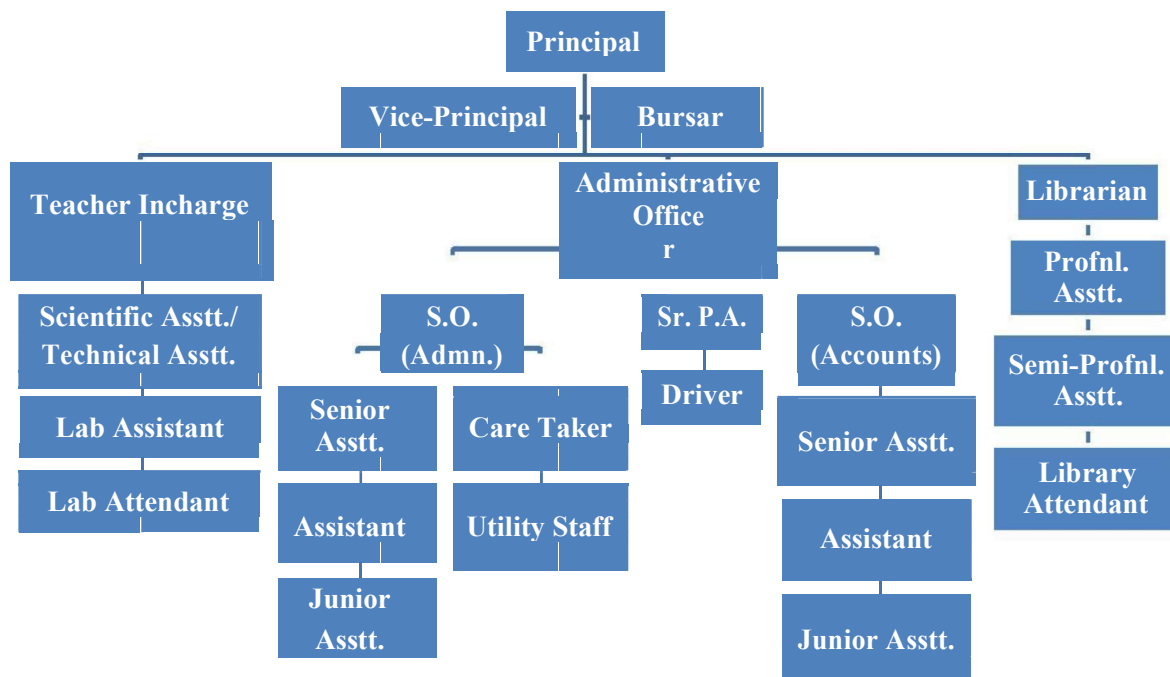
7. Mechanism available for monitoring the service delivery and public grievance resolution
