The students are hereby informed to give preferences for Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) to be studied in the forthcoming Semester III (Academic Session 2025-26). Please read the following very **carefully** before filling the form:

Under no circumstances paper once allotted will be changed by the college.

All students are strictly advised, according to the University of Delhi guidelines, they cannot study paper with same (or similar) title/syllabus under SEC, if a similar (or same) paper exists in their respective Discipline Specific Core/Elective. Also, SEC-3, GE-3 and VAC-3 cannot be same or similar.

If you had studied (or will be studying) any paper offered from the list in any previous semester(s), under any head: DSC/DSE/GE/VAC/SEC, then that particular paper will have least priority in the priority list.

Instructions for Value Addition Course - 3 (VAC-3) Option Form 2025-26

- 1. A student who pursues any undergraduate programme in the University and its Colleges, is offered a pool of Value Addition Courses, from which they have to choose one to study in the third semester.
- 2. Our college is offering 14 Value Addition Courses as listed below.
- 3. Please fill the form only once. Multiple submission of form shall exclude you from the allotment process. Please use your official email address issued by the college to access and fill this form.
- 4. All the fields are mandatory to be filled.
- 5. Enter the details carefully and verify them before submitting the form.
- 6. You have to select one and only one paper for each of the preferences, otherwise you won't be able to submit the form. You have to fill all of these Value Addition Courses in the order of your preference. The Preference 1 is to be given to the course of the most interest to you and Preference 14 to be given to the course of the least interest to you.
- 7. You shall be allotted Only One course by the college which will be different from the one that you studied/appeared in the previous semester(s) examination(s).
- 8. The Papers that you have studied in the previous two semesters should be given the least preferences.
- 9. The allotment shall be done by the college on FIRST COME FIRST SERVED basis as per student preferences as best as possible and subject to availability of seats in a particular course.
- 10. Selecting a particular course as the Preference 1 does not ensure the allotment of the same course to that student.
- 11. Although it is highly unlikely, but you may be allotted with the course of least interest to you as well.
- 12. Upon the successful submission of this form, an auto-generated mail shall be sent to your email id. You are advised to retain the email for future requirements, if any.

Instructions for Generic Elective - 3 (GE-3) Option Form 2025-26

Please read the instructions given below carefully before filling the Option Form:

A student taking admission in any undergraduate course from 2022 onwards in Delhi University is required to study a Generic Elective (GE) paper in the 1st semester onwards. Generic Electives are a pool of courses meant to provide multidisciplinary or interdisciplinary education to students. These courses are offered by various disciplines of study (excluding the GEs offered by the parent discipline), in groups of odd and even semesters, from which a student can choose.

- 1. A student may be awarded Minor in a discipline, on completion of VIII Semesters, if he/she earns minimum 28 credits from seven GE papers (including 3 mandatory papers) of the same discipline.
- 2. The student must read the Delhi University undergraduate curriculum framework 2022 (UGCF 2022) carefully before filling the option form. The same is available at https://centenary.du.ac.in//userfiles/downloads/02032022_UGCF_compressed.pdf
- 3. The syllabus for each GE-3 course is available on the University website. For any query, the student may contact the TIC of the respective department.
- 4. The student must fill all the preferences for **GE-3** papers offered by the college carefully.
- 5. The **GE-3** would be allotted on the basis of the number of times a student has studied GEs of a particular discipline in previous semesters as well as on **first-come first-get** and in order of preference given by the student.
- 6. College reserves the right to allocate **GE-3** option to the students irrespective of the preferences.
- 7. a) The minimum number of students in a class/section is 20. The maximum number of students in a class/section is 60.
 - b) Any **GE-3** paper, which is opted by **less than 20** students shall not be offered in the upcoming semester as per Delhi University Notification No. Acad.I/Class size/2023/R-4425 dated 28th July 2023.
- 8. Students who will not abide by the deadline of filling the GE-3 option form, will be allotted GE-3 by the college as per the availability of seats in particular GE papers.
- 9. The students, **excluding those enrolled in BMS**, are required to fill the option form using the **institutional mail id** only. **The BMS students must use their email used on Samarth Portal**.
- 10. **GE-3** paper once allotted will not be changed under any circumstances.
- 11. The **GE-3** option chosen by a student **should not be similar (similarity of not more than 30%) to any of the DSC/DSE papers** mentioned in their respective undergraduate UGCF syllabi.
- 12. As per the Undergraduate Curriculum Framework 2022, students can choose a GE-3 course from the pool of **GE-3** or a **DSE** course from the pool **of DSE-1** (**Discipline Specific Elective-1**) courses. For DSE-1 courses, the students are informed to contact the respective departments.
