**For Generic Elective (GE) papers for B. Sc. (Hons.) Physics Semester IV**

**Please read the instructions given below carefully before filling the Option Form for Generic Elective (GE) Paper:**

1. The student of B. A. (Hons.)/B. Com. (Hons.)/B M S/B. Sc. (Hons.) Course in the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) program is required to study four Generic Elective (GE) papers, one in each semester from Semesters I to IV.
2. **Students must choose a GE paper of a department other than the one they are admitted to. For example, a student of B. A. Hons Psychology cannot take the GE paper offered by Psychology department.**
3. The students of B. A. (Hons.)/B. Com. (Hons.)/B. Sc. (Hons.)/B M S Course may opt for the Generic Elective (GE) of a particular department/discipline in each semester to earn 24 credits in the concerned discipline **in order to be eligible for post-graduate in that discipline.**
4. It is mandatory for the students of **B. Sc. (Hons.) Physics** to study Mathematics as Generic Elective (GE) papers, so that they are eligible for appearing and competing in entrance test for admission under P. G. Courses in various institutes.
5. The student must fill two preferences for GE paper carefully as the GE paper will be allotted as per the preferences. College reserves the right to allocate GE option other than the first preference.
6. **The student will not be permitted to change the options/preferences once allotted.**
7. The students will be allotted their first preference as far as possible.

The following are the GE papers offered by various departments/disciplines of the college.
