Nominations are invited from the eligible students for the election of three student members of the Internal Complaints Committee in terms of Section 4 (1) (c) of the University Grants Commission (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal of sexual harassment of women employees and students in higher educational institutions) Regulations, 2015.

In accordance with the above mentioned regulations, the college has presently functioning Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) with an inbuilt mechanism for gender sensitization against sexual harassment. The details regarding the functioning and responsibilities of the ICC are available in the above mentioned regulations.

The composition of ICC includes three students from the college that need to be elected through transparent democratic procedure.

The election of these three students involves the following steps:

- 1. Class Representative (CR) shall be elected from each section of each course of I, II and III year students.
- 2. CR of a class shall be chosen by the students of that class only. A student who obtains the maximum number of votes shall be elected as a CR of that class.
- 3. The election of CRs shall be done for the following classes:

The following shall be the eligibility criteria for being elected as a CR:

- (a) Must have secured at least 55% consolidated marks in the latest semester examination.
- (b) No backlog of papers.
- (c) Minimum 75% attendance in the previous semester.
- (d) Not subjected to any disciplinary action in the past and should not have any criminal record.

Any interested and eligible student may duly fill the nomination paper (Annexure I) and submit the same to his/her Teacher in Charge/Course Coordinator.
