ADVISORY : DUSU and KMVSU Elections 2024-2025

1. The Code of Conduct/Lyngdoh Committee guidelines, NGT order, the Delhi Prevention of Defacement of Property Act, 2007 "(Delhi Act 1 of 2009) (As passed by the Legislative Assembly of the National Capital Territory of Delhi on 31st March 2008) (17th January, 2009) and An Act to provide for the prevention of defacement of properties and for matters connected therewith or incidental there to in the National Capital Territory of Delhi are strictly to be followed in DUSU elections.

Any violations on above are liable to disqualifications and criminal punishments under above Guidelines and Acts.

All candidates are directed to only use the wall of democracies available in the campus of University of Delhi/Colleges for pasting handmade posters only.

- 2. No candidate or his supporters will indulge in any act of gross indiscipline as per provisions of the Ordinance XV B of the University of Delhi as listed below:
 - (a) Physical assault or threat to use physical force, against any member of the teaching and non-teaching staff of any College/Institution/Department and against any student within the University of Delhi.
 - (b) Carrying of, Use of or threat of use of any weapons.
 - (c) Any violation of the provisions of Civil Rights Protection Act 1976.
 - (d) Violation of the status, dignity and honour of students belonging to the Scheduled Castes and Tribes.
 - (e) Any practice whether verbal or otherwise derogatory to women.
 - (f) Any attempt at bribing or corruption in any manner.
 - (g) Wilful destruction of institutional property.
 - (h) Creating ill-will or intolerance on religious or communal grounds.
 - (i) Causing disruption in any manner of the academic functioning of the University System.
 - (j) The candidature of the candidate may be cancelled without prior intimation if the candidate/supporter is found to be involved in any such activities prohibited as per ordinance XV B of the University of Delhi.
- 3. The candidates and their supporters are also advised to campaign in small numbers to ensure that classes get least disturbed and to avoid the use of printed material for campaigning.
