1.	Low attendance of the students in the classrooms. (Recommendations of the concerned committee should be relaxed from case to case basis)	The attendance committee has given its recommendations which are to be considered on case to case basis with benefit of doubt to be given to students. The mentor-mentee program should be geared up to deal with students issues related to absenteeism, and other issues related to their mental health, classes, exams, and college. An open-air interaction with the students to be organised periodically in the amphitheatre.
2.	Infrastructure maintenance, repair and purchase/AMC/repair of new equipment and condemnation of obsolete equipment: ICT lab, Physics and Electronics labs, computer labs, classroom projectors, power points in the staff room tables for charging of the laptops.	Purchase of new computers/IT equipment has been sanctioned. Condemnation of obsolete equipment is in the process by the designated committees.
3.	New infrastructure due to 4 years in NEP curriculum, temporary rooms on the college roof till permanent expansion of the college	Will take place in due course of time (as per University of Delhi & Govt. directives/funding/grant for infrastructure).

5.	Purchase of new software (e.g., Tally) as per the latest curriculum.	Departments should the recommendations
6.	Podiums for the teachers in the class rooms	Through the purchase of new furniture.
7.	Disposing of the waste lying here and there in the college premises	Cleanliness services should be opted through various agencies on contract or tender basis.
8.	Lockers for teachers in the staff room.	Shall be procured
