(a) The duly filled nomination form along with the required self-attested documents (as written in the checklist, available on the college website) should be put in the sealed boxes kept in Room No. 115 (Chemistry Lab 2) of the College from Tuesday 08 September 2026 (11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.), Wednesday 09 September 2026 (10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.), and Thursday 10 September 2026 (10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.), along with a Demand Draft of Rs. 500/- in favour of the Principal, Keshav Mahavidyalaya, University of Delhi, from any nationalized bank, and an Indemnity Bond by way of affidavit (Affidavit on Rs. 100/- stamp paper duly attested and notarized), Surety Bond on Rs. 100/- non-judicial stamp paper duly attested and notarized, Affidavit on Rs. 10/- stamp paper for each post.

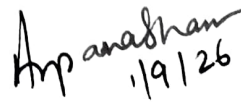
